## 1. Invention Title.

### Embeddable web forms application engine

## 2. Invention Summary.


A reusable, multiuser web-forms application engine (standalone or embedded) and reporting system designed to collect and update user supplied data for scheduled and unscheduled events including RFPs, provisioning, and event registrations.

## 3. Invention Description.

The reusable web-forms application engine acts as a subsystem to one or more external web applications or functions as a standalone app. The web-forms engine handles event scheduling, form display, layout, submission, data collection and reporting, and tracks which external apps utilize which forms. Look and feel of each form is managed by the CSS styling of each web app incorporating the web-forms engine, or an individual CSS when the web-forms app is utilized standalone.

The permissions layer, which integrates and authenticates with LDAP/Active Directory, manages access to form layout, submission, notification and data collected. Admins see only the forms they create. Edit permissions can be extended to additional admin(s). End users can submit forms as authenticated or unauthenticated users. When authenticated, users can save form data for later editing and submission.

The notifications processing sends confirmation to the submitter and admin(s) when forms are submitted, and provides for the ability to customize the email message sent.

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

The web-forms application engine can be utilized across multiple web applications, in place for creating the same replicated form functionality in each application.

## INVENTION DISCLOSURE

Service providers, such as cable companies, increasingly must provide online web sites, portals, and applications as a vital means of interfacing with the customer and other stakeholders. The web-forms application engine provides a reusable form capability that can be reused across multiple web sites and applications.

4. **How is this invention different from existing products, processes, systems?**

Other types of forms-based web applications exist for online surveys, form layout and submission, each having their own individually created forms logic and capability. The web-forms application engine is a “create once – use many” forms capability that can be reused across multiple disparate web applications.
